Adoption of the minutes of August and September Board meetings was deferred until the November meeting.

KS reported on restoration activities and ideas for restoring the restoration committee. She has solicited bids for the design of the redwood site trail, and provided an update on the Dimond Park creek bank failure and trail work. FOSC is now registered with the Volunteer Center online.

SM provided an update on the Bella Vista grant, the Watershed Project database grant, ivy project, the trail map project, the Rose Grant and Water Quality grant. MR agreed to do signs for the old site in Dimond Park; KO will do oak tree care mailout. On Dec 9, MR will lead a hike to educate the public on oak trees

The education committee will meet to discuss new strategies for the education program and report back to the Board in the next month or two.

Ideas for a FOSC tenth anniversary celebration were discussed. It was decided to hold an event in late March 2007 using Joaquin Miller Community Center if available.

A memorial for Elliot Smith was discussed. The Board agreed that some kind of carved bench would be appropriate for the Dimond Canyon restoration area, if wood/log could be obtained.

Nursery outreach for more volunteers is needed. Will be discussed at next meeting.
